Picking Up in the Evening

Please remember that **only adults can pick children** up from the school. This means that anyone picking up children must be 18 years old or over.

Also they must be named on our system. If the adult is not named on our system then we will not allow the child to leave.

We do this in the interests of safeguarding all children, which is at the forefront of what we do.

Late Pick Ups

We are seeing an increasing number of parents picking up children late from school.

This includes from After School Clubs, School Clubs and Choir Performances. If you are late picking up children from any club or trip you will receive a warning letter. If it happens again then your child will not be allowed to return to the club or external choir performances.

Please respect our staff and your child by being punctual.

School Uniform

We will be checking that children are in the correct school uniform next week. We are seeing an increasing number of children not in the correct uniform for school, incorrect PE kit and wearing trainers.

Please follow our agreed school uniform at all times.
