### Reception Intake September 2019

Please remember if your child is due to start Reception in September 2019 then the closing date for applications is January 15<sup>th</sup> 2019. *Please remember your child must be fully toilet trained before starting either Nursery or Reception.*

You must fill in one of our admission forms (*available from the office or on our web site*) and also get your Parish Priest to fill in the Supplementary form.

If you do not apply as explained above your child will not be considered for a place.

**Please note that being in our Nursery does not guarantee a place in our Reception Class.**

### Parents Evening Autumn Term 2018

Many thanks to those of you who have returned your appointment times for our upcoming Parent's Evening on 12<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> of November. Please be on time as we have a very tight schedule.

Parents of Reception, Class 1 and Class 2 – please supervise your children whilst waiting in the hall. Children are not allowed to play on the stage and noise in the hall should be kept to a minimum.

### Nursery Intake September 2019

Please remember if your child is due to start Nursery in September 2019 we are now taking applications. Your child must be 3 years of age before starting our Nursery.

We currently offer free 15 hour places, 30 hours for those parents who qualify and if you are eligible for 15 hours but *wish to buy extra hours*, every effort will be made to accommodate.

You must fill in one of our admission forms (*available from the office or on our web site*) and also get your Parish Priest to fill in the Supplementary form.

*Please remember your child must be fully toilet trained before starting either Nursery or Reception.*

### School Fund

Please refer to the letters you will have received recently regarding our school fund. Payment of this fund allows the school to purchase equipment or items which will benefit the whole school. Your contribution is much needed!

Payments can be made through ParentPay or by cash/cheque in the school office.

### Food Allergies / Food Intolerance

Please be advised that Chartwell's, our hot meal providers, have informed us that unless medical evidence is produced which proves your child has an allergy/intolerance then your wishes cannot be accommodated.

If you do have medical evidence as to your child's allergy/intolerance then please collect a form from the school office which will need to be completed along with the supporting medical evidence.

### **Parent Pay**

Please be advised that as of **January 2019** we will not be accepting cash payments to our school office, you can **only pay through Parent Pay**.

At the moment we have a very small percentage of parents using Parent Pay to pay for school lunches, breakfast club, after school club or the school fund. Please refer to the letter you were sent in the Summer Term with you payment codes on. After Half Term after school enrichment clubs will be added.

If you have lost the code please speak to the school office as soon as possible.
