It's been a very busy few weeks again at St Saviour's and we're very excited about Sports Day today and our Book Week Celebrations next week!

## End of Year Results

As we eagerly await the return of our Year 6 SATs scores we can confirm the following figures so far –

Class	St Saviour's School 2018	Comparison to 2017 Results
Reception Class	GLD Pass = 86% (25/29 children)	86% (+/- 0%)
Class One Phonics	Pass = 83% (24/29 children)	83% (+/- 0%)
Class 2 SATs Reading	Pass = 82% (23/28 children)	86% (up %16)
Class 2 SATs Writing	Pass = 75% (21/28 children)	86% (up 6%)
Class 2 SATs Maths	Pass = 82% (23/28 children)	86% (up 20%)

\* One child = 3.54%

Huge congratulations to Miss Tew and her Reception Team, Mrs Cunningham and Miss Bull and Mr Mercer and Mrs Barnett for working so hard with the children to achieve such fantastic results.

## GDPR

Mrs Reid has been doing an awful lot of work behind the scenes regarding the new GDPR regulations which came into force in May. A number of forms have gone out which need to be signed and returned asap.

If we do not receive them your child will not be allowed to use the internet at school and/or go on local trips!

## End of Year Reports

Another big change will be the way End of Year reports are sent home. From now on the End of Year reports cannot be sent home with a child. **They must be collected by an adult from the class teacher** in person.

This ensures reports are not dropped on the way home with lots of your personal data on them.
