



Think about books from the authors perspective. Why do you think the author chose to describe certain characters in the way they did? How did they use dialogue (speech) to move the story on? What is the author trying to make you think or feel?

Literacy skills

In literacy we will have a focus on narrative writing. We will cover flashbacks and various other genres of narrative writing including short stories, fantasy and science fiction and adventure stories. We will have a focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar throughout the term.

Work out how much things cost when shopping. Add up items and see if you can get close to the total. How much change would you get? If there is a sale, what would be the discount if an item was 50%, 30% or 25% OFF?

Topic skills

The children will find out about how humans have poisoned our planet, with pollution, pesticides and radiation, and how we are learning to change our ways and clean up after ourselves!

Class 6 – Autumn term

Homework: English and maths will be given out on a Wednesday and is expected back the following Monday.

Reading: please ensure your child is reading for 15 minutes per night. Ask them questions about what they have read.

PE: Children will need their PE kit on a Wednesday and Thursday

Maths skills

Practise formal written methods of calculation that include whole and decimal numbers. Measure sides and angles and draw shapes accurately. Solve multi-step, routine and non-routine problems that involve the four operations.

Potions and Poisons

Encourage your child to save energy or recycle and research ways to do this. It could be as simple as turning off a light in an empty room or helping recycle household items.

RE skills

During the topic 'Sources' pupils will learn about the Bible as the story of God's love, told by the people of God and the Bible in daily life. We will describe and show an understanding of the Bible, the beliefs, ideas and feelings of Christians and make links between them.

Talk about the Bible being made up of lots of different books from different perspectives. Who is recounting the events? Which events are told by more than one person? How many books of the Bible do they know?
