Rationale

In the 2018 - 2019 academic year St Saviour's RC Primary School received **£17,720** PE Grant.

We are using the funding to -

- Buy-in expert coaching for all classes from Nursery to Year 6.
- Deliver CPD for our Teachers to ensure effective and high quality first teaching for all our pupils.
- Enhance Lunch Play for children in Yr 1 to 6 with organised team games 12.15 to 1.30 daily
- Organise and release staff so we can compete in Inter School games within the Lewisham community.
- Organise a Sports Day in which our children and parents can take part in sporting events and celebrate healthy living as a community.
- Organise and deliver a wider range of sporting activities as part of our after school Enrichment Clubs.
- Improve the range and quality of our PE equipment.
