Doing household chores or even a paper round for money could help young people become better savers in the future. Research from the Royal Economic Society found that the more pocket money kids are given, the more likely they are to spend it straight away. Why do you think this might be the case?

In 2001, Pupils at a school in West Yorkshire were offered money if they turned up to their lessons.

The Ridings School offered £5 for each term completed.

That meant the children could have earned more than £60 a year if they went to all their classes!
