English

In literacy we will be looking at a range of books about being unique and about being kind such as Elmer, The rainbow fish and Only one you. We will be retelling stories using fun adjectives focusing on capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Religious Education

This term in RE the children will be looking at our families and God's love.

Discussing the importance of prayers and thanking God for his love and care.

Maths

We started our term off by looking at numbers one more and one less to 20. This term in maths we will be focusing on counting forwards and backwards, looking at counting in 10's and number formation. We will also be recapping 2D shapes and learning about 3D shapes. Exploring different units of measurement and comparing objects of different lengths.

Humanities

As our topic is 'All about me' we will be looking at our local area. This half term we will take a visit to our local library and take a walk to our local park. For history we will be looking at people who help us and our own personal time line.

In ICT we will be learning and understanding what algorithms are. We will also be looking at inputting simple instructions into a computer.

Art & DT

We will be looking at self-portraits and how different artists view themselves. One of the artists we will be looking at is Paul Klee, after exploring his different techniques we will have a go at doing a self-portrait, Klee style.

Science

In science this half term we will be exploring our five different senses. We started the term off last week eating sweet and salty popcorn and talking about how it affected our different senses. We will also look at labelling the human body.
