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Dear Parents and Carers, welcome back! We have had an excellent beginning to the term with your lovely children. They have been settling in and adapting to the new challenges in Year 1. Our door is always open if you have any questions or concerns. ### English

In Literacy we will be looking at a range of books about feelings, families and familiar settings, including The Colour Monster, Five Minutes' Peace and Cave Baby. We will be retelling stories using fun adjectives, focusing on capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

### Religious Education

This term in RE the children will be looking at our families and God's love. They will discuss the importance of prayers and thank God for his love and care.

### Maths

This term in Maths we will be focusing on counting forwards and backwards, using a range of resources to help us. We will explore place value, number formation and finding one more and one less than a given number. We will also be revisiting 2D shapes and their properties and will learn more about 3D shapes and how to identify them.

## All About Me!

### Humanities

As our topic is 'All About Me', we will be looking at our local area. For History we will be looking at our own personal timeline.

### ICT

In ICT we will be learning and understanding how to use technology safely. We will also use our ICT skills to recreate portraits and firework pictures using paint programmes.

### Art & DT

In Art, we will be creating self-portraits and looking at how different artists view themselves. In DT, we will use our senses to plan and make sweet and salty dishes.

### Science

In Science this half term we will be learning about our five senses, identifying which senses we use when exploring everyday objects and events. We will also look at and label the human body.

### PE

The children will play team and balls games, while developing their movement skills such as running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as exploring their spatial awareness.

### Music

In our Music lessons the children will be learning about musical scores. They will explore rhythm and sound through body percussion and listen to different sounds, identifying the quality and pitch of each sound.

### Other information

Please teach your child to tie their laces if they wear laced up shoes or trainers to school. Please ensure your child's uniform (including coat) has their name in.
